

Kamruzzaman | Name of A Creative Genius

Ordinary people do not see what a creative genius sees. Those who are creative geniuses have a different perspective on life. Kamruzzaman, a writer and philosopher, is one such person.

Where was he born? What was his academic education like?

Kamruzzaman was born on 20 April 1958 in Chittagong. From Pahartali Railway High School, he passed SSC in Science in 1977. He passed HSC (Commerce Department) from Khulna City College in 1979. He graduated in 1982 under the University of Rajshahi with the highest marks in accounting. He got Master's degree with unique excellence from the same university in 1986.

In what ways does the life of a creative genius become diverse?

Worked as journalist:

After passing SSC, Zaman started journalism along with his studies. In addition, he got involved in leftist politics. After graduating, again journalism became his profession. The daily “Aunirban” appointed him to the post of an assistant news editor. Soon after joining, the authority promoted him to the position of news editor.

He used to write editorial, sub-editorial and economics pages regularly. Due to the lack of freedom of the press, he regularly edited the quarterly news magazine "Bidrohi Borno". A dream was in him to be the owner of the newspaper.

He started writing essays, stories and poems regularly in protest of the

irregularities of the society.

Because of the complicated approval process of the newspaper, he resigned from the post of the editor.

A few other jobs:

His next job was as an assistant accountant for Amam Sea Food.

Worker's revolution led to his dismissal.

Thus, the career of a teacher became his choice. Dhaka and Khulna were two locations where he planned to open coaching centers to nurture creative talent in students. After a few months, teaching career stopped.

Then he joined as an accountant in a pharmaceutical company. Having obtained his master's degree, next he joined Frozen Food Ltd. as an accountant.

An expatriate's life:

He left the country for Europe in October 1987, hoping to collect money for the newspaper. Furthermore, he wished to acquire a fellowship degree. However, the prospect of higher education in Germany was narrow.

Therefore, he tried to leave Germany for the U.S.A. After much effort, he got his visa for the U.S.A. However, due to some reasons he did not leave Germany. Finally, Kamruzzaman stayed there along with his family.

Since the start of his career, he worked in a mechanical company in Germany for many years. In 2003, printing business started as his profession.

In 2006, he established Child Education Development project (BCEDP)

for Bangladeshi homeless and street children. Its headquarter was in Germany. Since then, this charity organization has been giving them free education. Over the time, the project widens and now gives free medical service along with accommodation facilities. It also includes rehabilitation program.

The way he lives his personal and family life:

He got married in 1985 and built his family. In 1989, he took his wife, Sultana Jaman Nila in Germany. In 1990 and 1995, he was blessed with a baby-son and a baby-daughter.

After much effort, he got his visa for the U.S.A. However, due to wife's illness and family-insolvency in Bangladesh, he did not leave Germany. Until now, he continues to stay there along with his family.

How do different functions at home and abroad demonstrate his inventive virtuoso?

Even with limited opportunities, talented individuals succeed. It is the case with Kamruzzam. By virtue of his talent and diligence, he had done a ton for his own and others too.

He is simultaneously a writer, literary figure, social worker, humanitarian leader and philosopher, commentator.

Most notable among all his creative works are three novels. The writer depicts human and social misery in his novels.

How excellent academic textbook for kids is!

Finally, he devotes his entire time and energy to improving the welfare of homeless children in Bangladesh. This work combines his creative genius with humanity.
